Come and Worship Week 4

*“When [the wise men] saw the star, they were overjoyed. <sup>11</sup> On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him.” - Matthew 2:10-11*

*“Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; <sup>7</sup>for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.” - Psalm 95:6-7*

- **KNEEL IN PURSUIT.**

*“As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to [Jesus] and fell on his knees before him. “Good teacher,” he asked, “what must I do to inherit eternal life?” - Mark 10:17*

- **KNEEL IN REPENTANCE.**

*“When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, “Oh, Lord, please leave me—I’m too much of a sinner to be around you.” - Luke 5:8 NLT*

- **KNEEL IN SUBMISSION.**

*“[Jesus] withdrew about a stone’s throw beyond [his disciples], knelt down and prayed, <sup>42</sup>“Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.” - Luke 22:41-42*

### **YOU CAN KNEEL NOW OR YOU CAN KNEEL LATER**

*“And being found in appearance as a man, [Jesus] humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! <sup>9</sup> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” - Philippians 2:8-11*
