EXCUSES Week 4

“Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life.” – Psalm 139:23-24

“In your anger do not sin”: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold.” - Ephesians 4:26-27 NIV

“Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. “It is written,” he said to them, “My house will be called a house of prayer,’ but you are making it ‘a den of robbers.’” The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them.” - Matthew 21:12-14 NIV

WHEN JESUS GOT ANGRY:

- 1) Jesus was angry on BEHALF of those who were MISTREATED.

“Make allowance for each other’s faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.” – Colossians 3:13 (NLT)

- 2) He FLIPPED TABLES; He didn’t FLIP PEOPLE.

“And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.” – 1 Corinthians 13:13

- 3) He LOVED and HEALED those who were HURTING.

“The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them.” - Matthew 21:14 NIV

“... for He [God] forgave all our sins. ¹⁴He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. In this way, He disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by His victory over them on the cross.”- Colossians 2:13-15 NLT
