The Process & Results of Obedience

1. God is PERISITENT in His CALL.

“Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time:” – Jonah 3:1

God is more interested in our OBEDIENCE than our COMFORTS.

“I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, ‘Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.’” – Acts 26:14

2. God’s MESSAGE does not CHANGE.

“Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.” – Luke 21:33

3. Our MESSAGE is most EFFECTIVE when we have EXPERIENCED it PERSONALLY FIRST.

“He [God] comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us.” – 2 Corinthians 1:4

HELPFUL HINT:

“Never questions in the dark what you know to be true in the light.”

4. Our MESSAGE can CHANGE NATIONS.

“If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.” – 2 Chronicles 7:14
